

Rising 7th Level Logic School FAQ

Technology

- **Does my student need to bring a laptop to school?**
 - A laptop will be required at home all year and at school during the second semester for Computer Navigation. Occasionally, teachers may request it at other times for specific projects, but typically laptops are not used daily for note-taking.
- **What kind of laptop does my student need?**
 - PC or Chromebook with at least a 1.6 GHz CPU. Students will be on the internet using a typing site as well as our school's Google apps. Macintosh computers are not preferred, but are acceptable if that is the only option available.
- **When will my student get a school email address?**
 - Your student will receive a CLA email during the LRS Retreat. Training on how to login and use the account will take place then.

Course Offerings

- **Will my student have “specials” in Logic School?**
 - Your student will have electives based on teacher availability. A google form with descriptions will be sent out to record student first, second and third choices before the start of school.
- **Will my student have foreign languages in Logic School?**
 - We do not offer foreign languages in Logic School. Instead we offer Computer Navigation and Informal Logic. Languages will be offered again in Rhetoric School.
- **Will my student have different options for math courses?**
 - Math placement into a higher level is by invitation only. Teacher input and testing are used to determine placement.

Curriculum

- **Which book is required for summer reading?**
 - Level 7 - The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe
 - Level 8 - A Wrinkle in Time
- **When will we receive the parent purchase list?**
 - Lists are updated and on the website by July 1

Uniforms

- **Are uniform requirements any different than Grammar School?**
 - The only difference is that Logic and Rhetoric students may wear socks other than white, black, gray, or brown.

- **Is the dress code different on Fridays?**
 - Beginning in the fall of 2024, students will be required to wear regular uniforms on Fridays unless it is a special dress down day approved by our Head of School.

School Supplies

- **When will we receive supply lists?**
 - These lists are part of the parent purchase list that will be on the website July 1.
- **How different are the supply lists from Grammar School?**
 - The lists are specific to each grade level, but we try to keep them as similar as we can.
- **Do we need to purchase a calculator for math?**
 - Calculator requirements are found on the parent purchase list. They will be used more once students get to high school.
- **When will binders be set up?**
 - STUDENTS will set up binders during the first week of school.

House System

- **What is the House System?**
 - Our school has adopted a British-style House System. Through this we have established distinct communities within our community. They are places where not only students, 7th grade to 12th grade, belong, but faculty as well. Places where values are modeled and the common goods of our community are shared openly and willingly. Places where you can know and be known. Places where you can be urged to live a life that honors and glorifies God. It is there that our students learn for themselves through the shared experience with others what it is they are intended to do. We hope to form the hearts and desires of students through:
 - Nurturing relationships across LRS grade levels and faculty
 - Leadership, friendly competition, and service
 - Positive peer pressure and mentorship
