PCs and Macs need at least a quad-core processor. Windows 10 or 11 with 64-bit Windows. MacOS must be Catalina (10.15) or above. Chromebooks need at least a dual-core processor. Chromebooks also must be able to support Chrome 116 or better. Any Macbook meeting the aforementioned recommendations is acceptable.
